

Success Center FAQs

Free academic support services are available to all Augusta Tech students, including tutoring for all Learning Support courses and also for credit courses in English, Math, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and COMP1000 (Intro. to Computers); Assistance with writing assignments for any credit class; help in getting started with Blackboard; improvement of general academic skills; and helpful links to Free Tutoring websites and other resources at the Success Center <https://www.augustatech.edu/student-resources/success-center.cms> The Success Center is located on the Ground Floor of the ITC/Library Building on the main campus, and Student Services staff can connect students with Success Center staff on all satellite campuses by calling the campus of their choice and scheduling an appointment. Students can also continue to use the online Smarthinking tutoring tool. **Please Note: Tutoring in the Success Center is available by appointments only.**

Will the Success Center offer tutoring fall term? Yes, the Success Center will offer tutoring in the fall **By Appointments Only**, while adhering to the CDC social distancing guidelines and guidelines established by the school. This will include wearing your school ID and wearing a face covering at all times.
